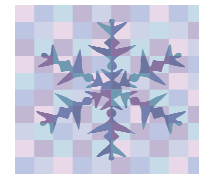

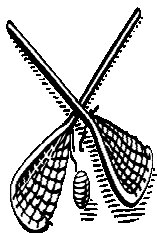

### VOLLEYBALL

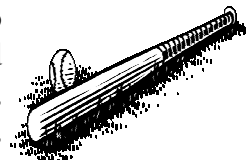

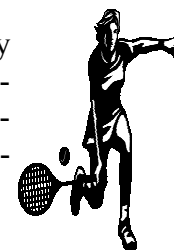
